### Team Clinics Update

La Rita Haffey, district health nurse coordinator, spoke to the board about the progress of Team Clinics, the remote medical service provider located at several school sites across the district. The clinics went live Sept. 17, and since that time they have seen 46 patients, a mixture of students and staff members. The only patients who had to be sent home due to illness were all teachers, Haffey said. The number-one reason for students to be seen at the clinics was ear infections, she said. She is hoping the program expands to other sites in the future. Over 300 students and staff members have pre-registered for the Team Clinics program.

### Jefferson Highlights Robotics Team
