The information in this report may be helpful to you. There are many positive things to note. First, you will notice that SMS has scored higher than the average community group in 8th grade Science. It is important to note that the 8th grade Science Test is a cumulative test that encompasses instruction from all three grade levels. Second you will notice that our 7th grade Math scored higher than the community group. Overall our Math scores are trending up here at SMS. You will notice that for several of the tested areas our students lag slightly behind the state average, but we are steadily gaining in all areas.

Please remember that reports like these have limitations. They are not current. Rather, all of the data reflects what occurred during the 2016-2017 school year. It is also important to note that this report shows only one group of students and their performance for one year. This report lacks any historical data that would allow us to track an entire grade's performance over a three-year middle school career. The data in this report shows results for different students every year. If that data were available, one might be able to form more accurate conclusions regarding trends in student performance. I urge you to read over this report and consider how you can become more involved in your child's education and achievement.

We continue to work to improve the learning environment in our school and have high expectations of everyone involved in the SMS family; students, parents, teachers, and staff. I appeal to you to do everything you can to encourage your students to take going to school seriously. 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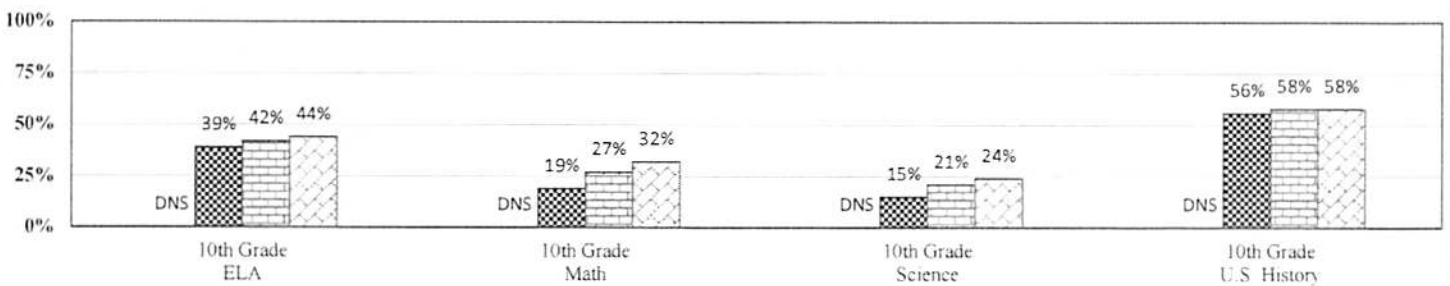

% of Students Scoring Proficient and Above by Grade and Subject

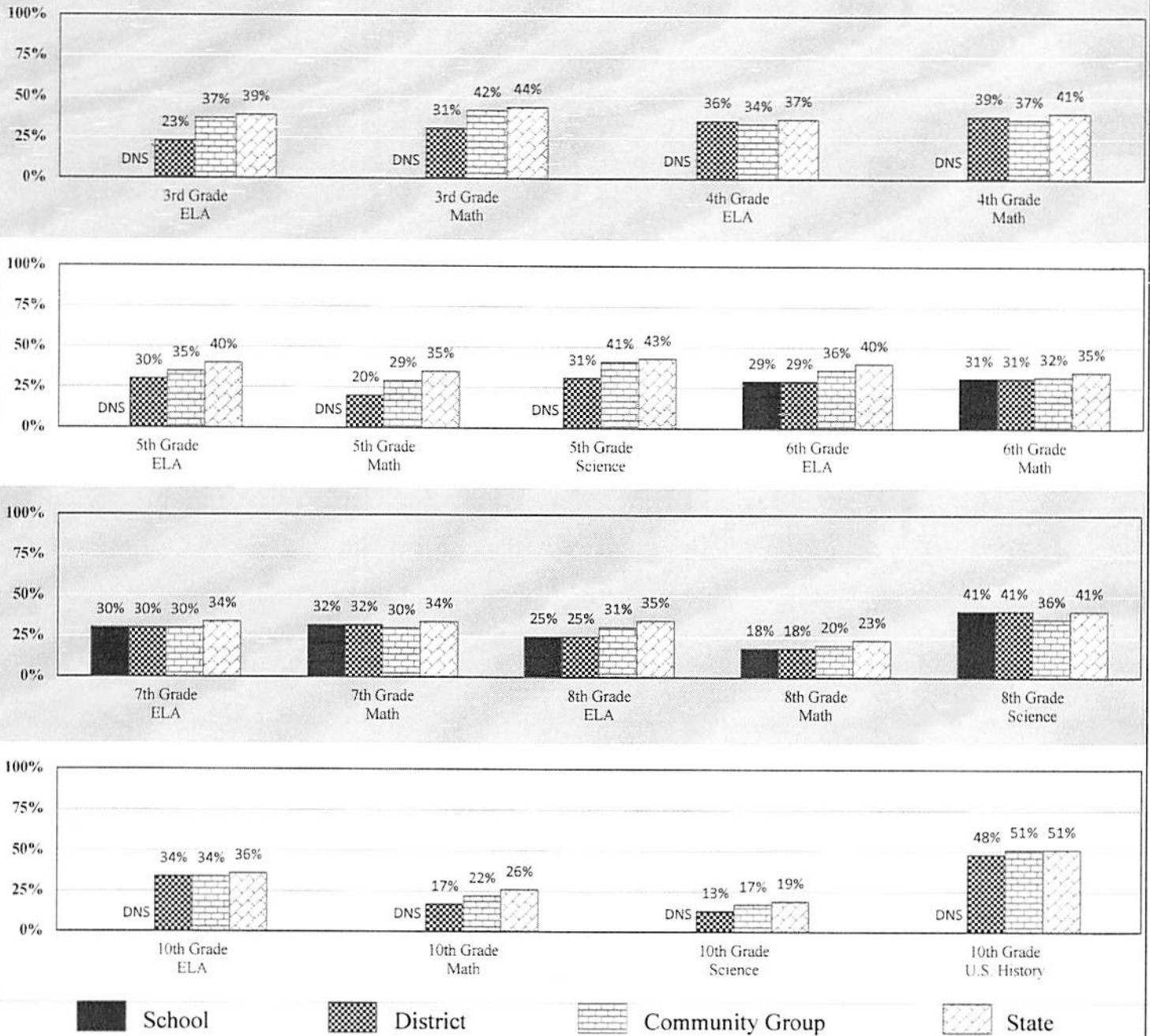
