

SHS School Expectations 20 - 21

Classroom:

- Face coverings play a critical role in preventing infection and should be used to reduce the spread of coronavirus. As a result, face coverings will be required in our school. Face coverings must not include messages or images that distract from the learning environment as outlined for other articles of clothing in our school dress code policy.
- When possible, social distancing procedures need to be followed.
- Students need to avoid sharing materials and supplies when possible.

Cafeteria:

- While in line, use social distancing. Please make sure to continually wear your mask.
- No more than 4 chairs are to be at a table. Both sides of the cafeteria, outside courtyard areas, and the library will be utilized during breakfast and both lunch periods.
- Masks are not required while actively eating.
- Food and drink should be consumed in the cafeteria, library (during lunch/breakfast) or outside at the tables.
- Once you are finished eating, students may return to their table or go outside. We ask that students do not congregate in the hallways.

Passing Period:

- In an effort to assist with the flow of traffic during the passing period, please walk on the right side of the hall (following the arrows), wear your mask, & maintain social distancing.
- Avoid standing or crowding in the middle of the hall. We ask that you get to your next class as quickly and safely as possible.
- Bathrooms and water fountains will be closed during this time. Teachers will provide opportunities to use these facilities during class time to avoid crowding. Students are encouraged to use refillable water bottles and use the school's bottle-filling stations. In the event we can turn off a water fountain bubbler without impacting the use of the bottle-filling station, we will.
- To limit exposure, we will avoid using lockers.

General Expectations:

- Wash/Sanitize hands as often as possible.
- Maintain Social Distancing (3 to 6 feet away from others) when possible.
- Avoid touching the inside of your mask or sharing masks with others.
- Avoid sharing materials/supplies with others as much as possible.
- When necessary, help your teachers sanitize surfaces.
- Students will need to bring a water bottle; the refilling stations located near the cafeteria and library will be accessible.
- Refrain from touching your face.
- Avoid touching other people or their belongings.
